








of the people in Balthali was quite different from city people as they were busy with farming and local retail business.



Apart from that we get a brief understanding of importance of regulations and how it is used to stabilize streamline and enhance the industry. The purpose is to make permanent legal system and laws and temporary laws and directives.









Sociology Trip BBA-BI Sem II

Nestled amidst the picturesque landscapes of Kavrepalanchok district, just a stone's throw away from the bustling capital city of Kathmandu, lies the charming Balthali Village. This article presents a comprehensive survey conducted in Balthali Village:

The objective of this report is to understand how technology is affecting the adolescents population in Balthali.

The trip was also aimed to gather data on their usage patterns and the effects it has on their physical and mental health, social life, and academic performance. The trip was also aimed to examine the role of parents, educators, and other stake- holders in managing theuse of technology among adoles- cents. The methodology used in this study involved both qualitative and quantitative data collection methods.

Surveys were conducted and interviews with adolescents, parents, and educators, as well as observation of technology use in the community. The study was conducted on 8th February 2023, and we collected data

from 10 respondents.

The study showed that adolescents in Balthali are exposed to various types of technology, including smartphones, laptops, and social media platforms. The results showed that the use of technology had both positive and negative effects on adolescents. On the positive side, technology provides adolescents with a platform to explore their interests, communicate with friends and family, and access information.

However, on the negative side, technology overuse can lead to physical health problems, poor academic performance, and social isolation. The study concludes that while technology is an essential aspect of modern life, adolescents must be taught how to use it responsibly to avoid negative effects.
